

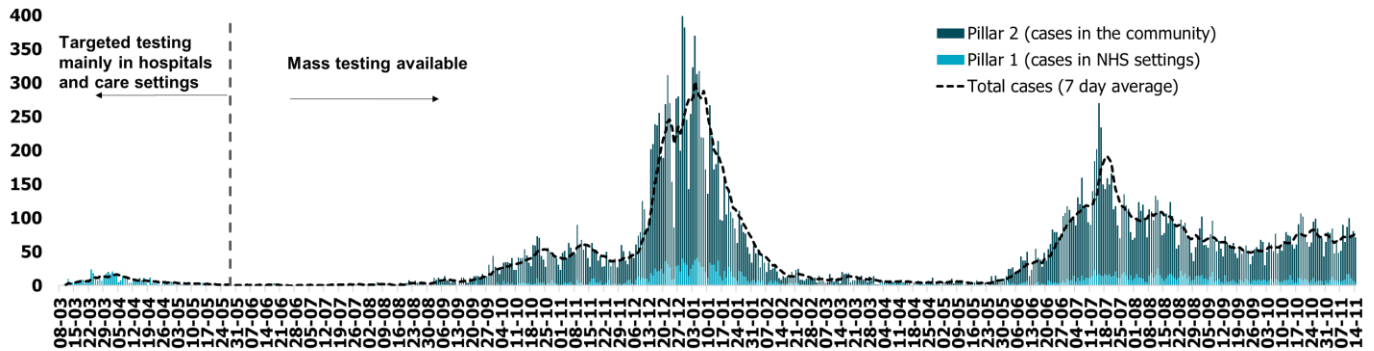
# Covid-19 in Islington

## Last week (08 November – 14 November)

**Deaths 1**

**New cases per day average 81**

Number of daily cases in Islington, 08 March 2020 to 14 November 2021



It is important to note that as mass testing wasn't available until 28<sup>th</sup> May 2020, many cases early on will not have been tested. Therefore, current number of cases cannot be compared to the start of the pandemic.

Islington has had a total of **28,468** confirmed cases.

**Weekly incidence rate = 229 per 100,000**



This is lower than London's rate at 283 per 100,000 and is the 4th lowest amongst the 32 London boroughs. This is higher than last week's rate (183) and is rated dark red.

**5.6% of tests are positive**



For every 1,000 tests taken 56 on average are coming back positive. A weekly percentage of 5.6% is rated amber.

These indicators are RAG (red-amber-green) rated to indicate whether they are good or bad.

**London's R number = 0.9-1.1**



An R number between 0.9 and 1.1 means that on average every 10 people infected will infect between 9 and 11 other people. If the R value is above 1 the pandemic is growing, if it is below 1 the pandemic is shrinking.
