Islington Equalities Review

On the 11 April 2012, ICN collaborated with the Islington BME Forum to host a focus group on how Islington can better identify and respond to the needs of our diverse population. The Islington Equalities Review (IER) was informed by the resulting report which directly supported several of the IER recommendations:

- **Increase the diversity of school governors and teachers to ensure that they are as reflective as possible of the population of the schools in the borough**
- **Facilitate the development of an external equalities forum which will provide scrutiny and strategic challenge**
- **Provide clear and publicly accessible information on how Islington council is meeting its equality objectives**

Islington council is addressing all IER recommendations and progress is detailed in the 'Delivering Leadership and Excellence in Equalities' report available on the council website.
